- C In the spectrogram shown below, the segments have been delimited, some with dashed lines as they do not have sharp boundaries. In each of the spaces above the spectrogram write a symbol for a sound that has the same manner of articulation as that segment. Those for the first segment have been filled in as examples. A few other segments that are particularly difficult to determine have also been filled in.

The spectrogram is an ordinary English sentence, containing no names, so obviously the third possibility shown for the first segment could not be correct, as no English sentence could begin with [ŋ]. Bearing in mind what sequences of sounds are possible in English, write as many words or syllables as you can. This is a true statement.
